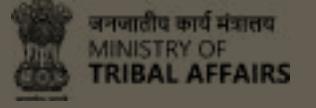

ABOUT EMRS SARADA

EMRS Sarada (Eklavya Model Residential School, Sarada) is a government-run institution located in Sarada, Salumbar district, Rajasthan. It operates under the flagship initiative of the Ministry of Tribal Affairs and is managed by the Rajasthan State EMRS Society. The school is dedicated to providing quality education to students from Scheduled Tribes (ST), aiming to bridge educational gaps and promote holistic development.



Events and Achievements

On 7 April 2025, Eklavya Model Residential School, Sarada, celebrated World Health Day with enthusiasm. Activities included a health awareness play, fitness tips from the physical education teacher, and motivational advice from the principal. 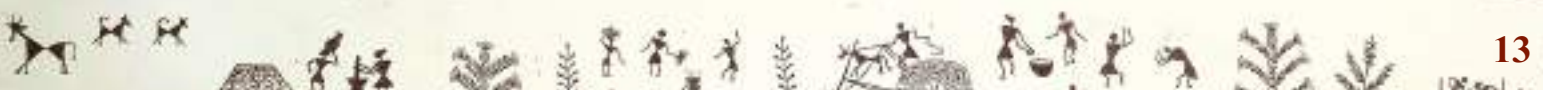

Hence, the Class XII Physics Practical Examination was successfully conducted on 27 January.



The biology laboratory at EMRS Sarada is a well-equipped facility designed for hands-on learning. It features modern tools like compound microscopes, anatomical slides, and specimens. Students conduct experiments in physiology and ecology using digital pH meters and measuring balances, fostering scientific curiosity and practical skills. Students demonstrated exceptional skill in advanced experiments, including DNA isolation and the study of pollen germination. By mastering these complex techniques, our students bridge the gap between theory and discovery, showcasing the high academic standards and scientific curiosity fostered at EMRS Sarada. The Biology Laboratory hosted a successful practical examination on January 29.



- The Chemistry laboratory of EMRS Sarada is well equipped with necessary apparatus, chemicals, and safety equipment. The lab provides a good learning environment for students to perform experiments practically. Regular practical classes and practice sessions are conducted to develop experimental skills. The Chemistry practical examination was conducted smoothly on 29 January in a well-organized manner.
